# TOM CLARKE - KATHLEEN DALY CLARKE MEMORIAL CELEBRATION



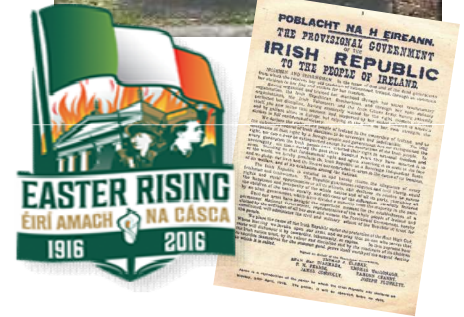
Sunday, April 3, 2016
