To insure a fair selection process, this Application Form must be completed and **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED WITH A NARRATIVE STATEMENT** explaining how this member is qualified for this award.

The narrative statement **MUST NOT INCLUDE** the name of the Junior member; her County or the name of her Division; or any other identifying comments (i.e., town of residence, parish, school, employer, family members, etc.). The narrative statement can indicate that the member was/is a Junior Division Officer, but shall not include the name of the County, or Division. The narrative portion of the application is the only part of the application that will be distributed to the Judging Committee for voting.

Any narrative statement that identifies the Candidate's identity will be disqualified.
