Once I receive these reports, I will e-mail them out to County Treasurers, who are responsible for e-mailing Division reports to their Division Treasurers. I will also e-mail these same reports to Treasurers of Single Divisions (with no County Board).
- EOY reports will be blank, except with the starting balance from Sandi Swift which will be included on your report, and this number is ‘not’ to be changed.
- All Treasurer (EOY) reports must be returned in Excel format only. Google Docs will not be accepted. LAOH National Treasurer, Sandi Swift, will only accept EOY reports in Excel format.
- December 2021 ‘bank statement’ must accompany your EOY report.
- If anyone needs to speak to me regarding their EOY report, once they receive it, my cell number and e-mail is listed below. I am also available to answer any Treasurer questions you may need answers too.

I will be sending out in early December 2021 more information on EOY Reports/Due Dates, per Capita taxes (National and State), and Appeals for Aid ‘annual’ fee. I am planning a Zoom meeting with County and Division Treasurers (late November or early December) shortly after the EOY reports are distributed.

Immigration & Education/Kathleen Stevens

Sisters, I hope you are all safe and well during this unusual time we are living in. As things begin to clear, and we are more free to be together, it is wonderful to see so many people we have missed over the past year and a half.

As the NYS LAOH Immigration and Education Chair, I would like to share with you some things I have learned recently. People attempt to come into the United States for many reasons. Some come here as a refugee; some as an asylum seeker; and others as an immigrant.

A refugee is a person who has fled his or her country of origin and is unable or unwilling to return because of a well-founded fear of being persecuted because of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group or political opinion. Once they have fled their home, they must apply for refugee status with an official entity, such as a government or the United Nations Refugee Agency, who determines whether a person meets the definition of a refugee, based on well-founded fear.

An Asylum Seeker is someone who is seeking international protection from dangers in his or her home country, however, asylum seekers must apply for protection in the country of destination, meaning they must arrive at or cross a border in order to apply.

An immigrant is someone who makes a conscious decision to leave his or her home and move to a foreign country with the intention of settling there. All people attempting to enter the United States, whether a refugee, an asylum seeker, or an immigrant, must go through a process, which is often quite lengthy.

I hope this information is helpful. I strongly encourage every LAOH Division in New York State to have an Immigration and Education Appointee on their Board.

On October 30th there will be a memorial Mass at St/ Patrick's Cathedral that I will be attending for all those we lost in the pandemic.

Dolores has actively brought to the forefront the importance of our support for FFAI and shares her compassion for those still affected from the "Troubles".
